Scenario: Log In and Change Password

Charlie needs to log into P3 for the first time.

Let's see how Charlie can do this.



Navigate to **gopennymac.com**.

2 At the top right of the page, click **Go To Portal**.

For new users, before performing the following steps, check your email for access credentials.





- **3** Once the login screen displays, enter your username and temporary password provided and click the *Login* button.
 - Click the **View** icon **(1)** if you would like to see your password to correct any mistakes.

Click the **Remember Me** button to save your login name. Password will not be saved.

Click the **Forgot Password** link to reset your password using your account email.





Once in P3, follow the next steps to change password:

- In the upper right hand corner of the website click on the drop-down **Your User Name** menu.
- **2** Three options display:
 - Manage Account
 - Change Password
 - Logout

Click on **Change Password** button.





- 3 Insert the *current password*.
- Insert a **new password**..
- i It should be different from the current password.
- 5 Re-enter your *new password*.
- 6 Click the **Save** button..

A small window will open to confirm you have successfully changed your password.

Password Rules

When setting up your new password, there are some rules that need to be taken into consideration. Let's go over them!



Characters

8 Characters Minimum Password Length.



Must have

- 1 Number
- 1 Special Character



Expiration date Password expires every 60 Days
